





Security Door by Josh Smith Stained Glass Mosaic by Gayle Swanbeck and Zoe Rhyne (School of the Arts Entrance)





UPDATES

Eight stained glass mosaic, floral design panels were made by Zoe Rhyne and Gayle Swanbeck, these 8"x10" panels were installed by Josh Smith into his beautiful art/security doors separating the gallery from the upstairs studios and at the entryway to the School of the Arts. Check them out in our fabulous centerfold photo collage, on our website, or in person. Additional improvements by Josh happened inside the building. Both the back hallway and a front craft room were re-painted. The transom above the gallery bathroom was repaired and reset with a stained glass mosaic artwork, repairs were done to some upstairs

studio doors, and new shelves were installed in the hallway closet leading into the classroom. More storage! Now here's my favorite. The small room in the School of the Arts is storage for more than 65 workshops and class supplies. The last time it was seriously cleaned and re-organized was almost 5 years ago. Josh, Zoe, Richard, Grace and I began the giant job of recreating the space into a place of function and beauty. Supplies were purchased, the room was cleaned, Josh built and installed permanent custom designed shelves, everything was cleaned, sorted, sent to the rummage fair, recycled, newly ordered on the shelves, labeled, or tossed. 
